

## CONTENT

### Abstracts should include:

- brief introduction
- aim(s) of the study
- methods used, including possible statistical methods
- summary of results
- conclusions
- No abbreviations or trade names are allowed in the title.

## LAYOUT

- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- The title should be concise and descriptive of the work to be reported. It should not exceed 20 words and must be written in CAPITAL letters.
- The author submitting the abstract should appear as the first named author. The first author is expected to be also the presenter. Give the authors names: Surname, First Name(s) of each author. Indicate with number(s) the affiliation(s).
- Key words, up to five
- Type the abstract text in Times New Roman, Font 12, single spacing
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words. Title, list of the authors and keywords are not included
- Presenting author is required to register for the meeting.
- Abbreviations should be placed in parentheses after the first time the word is used
- It is the author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract. Any errors in spelling, grammar or scientific fact in the abstract text will be reproduced as typed by the author
- All abstracts accepted for presentation will be published in the Program book.
